The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Present: M. Bullick, A. Dham, A. Metricarti, J. Moskal, T. Moyer, M. Stehman, and T. Weikel

Also Present: Mayor J. Guest, and Manager M. Leonard

The meeting minutes for May 11 & May 30, 2017 were presented and accepted upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

#### BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT & COMMUNICATIONS:

Manager requested a motion to advertise the crosswalk for construction at 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Main Street. Motion by M. Bullick seconded by T. Weikel. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard stated that the new website was completed except for a few minor items. Donna and Jess are working on the website.

Manager Leonard discussed the snow issue at the cul-de-sac on North 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Council wanted it posted "No Parking during Snow Event".

Manager Leonard discussed with Council turning over ownership of Main Street and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue from Penn Dot to the Borough owning them.

#### FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$140,340.09 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman. The motion passed unanimously.

#### PARK & RECREATION COMMITTEE:

T. Moyer reported that the next concert will be Sunday June 25, 2017 Ken Pierson at 6:30 PM.

#### PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE:

The report of the Royersford Fire Department for the month of May 2017 was presented and accepted upon motion by M. Bullick seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

A. Dham reported that there was a meeting with the new owner of 320 & 324 Main Street.

#### MAYOR:

Mayor Guest, under his authority, specified making the lower parking lot two hour parking on a temporary 60 day basis. The Mayor asked that the people that have the apartment next to Borough Hall be given six parking permits, 2 per apartment. The time of the 2 hour parking will be 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.
