The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

The Treasurers Report and Sewer & Solid Waste Collection Report for June 2017 was presented and accepted upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by T. Moyer. The motion passed unanimously.

#### BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT & COMMUNICATIONS:

Manager Leonard presented to Council Resolution #2017-12 Highway Transfer Program where the Borough takes ownership of Main Street and Second Avenue from the State. Motion by T. Weikel to move forward with Resolution #2017-12 seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard presented to Council an update of the CDBG Grant Program on Church Street. The progress is moving slow on the street.

Manager Leonard informed Council that the Public Works Department will be down a man due to an injury. Borough Council gave permission to hire a part time worker to fill the position.

Manager Leonard and Council discussed putting out an RFP for engineering breaking it down to Borough Engineer, Traffic Engineer, and Sewer Engineer. Motion to put the RFP out in the newspaper by J. Moskal seconded by T. Moyer. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard presented to Council Resolution #2017-13 Disposition of Records set forth in the Municipal Record Manual. Motion by J. Moskal seconded by T. Weikel. Motion passed unanimously.

#### VISITORS:

Elmer Knapp of 442 Walnut Street wanted to address Council regarding the fees for apartment rentals.

Bill Pinkerton of the Pink Moose wanted to address Council regarding a military memorial. Council told Bill to give the manager a sketch of what you want to do.

#### FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$98,417.97 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

**WASTE WATER COMMITTEE:**

The report of the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent for the month of June 2017 was presented and accepted upon motion of M. Stehman seconded by T. Weikel. The motion passed unanimously.

**PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE:**

The report of the Director of Public Works for the month of June 2017 was presented and accepted upon motion of J. Moskal seconded by T. Moyer. The motion passed unanimously.

The report of the Code Enforcement Officer for the month of June 2017 was presented and accepted upon motion by J. Moskal seconded by T. Moyer. The motion passed unanimously.

**PARK & RECREATION COMMITTEE:**

T. Moyer reported that there is a concert at Victory Park on Sunday August 13<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 PM.

**PERSONNEL COMMITTEE:**

T. Weikel made a motion to appoint Scott Higgins to the Human Relation Board seconded by J. Moskal. Motion passed unanimously.

**MAYOR:**

Mayor Guest reminded everyone that on August 1, 2017 is National Night Out from 5 PM to 8 PM. He hopes to see everyone support the National Night Out.

**SOLICITOR:**

Solicitor B. Dunbar reported on a proposed snow and ice emergency ordinance for no parking in any cul-de-sacs during a snow event. Motion by J. Moskal seconded by T. Weikel to advertise the snow ordinance. Motion passed unanimously.

Council went into Executive Session at 7:55 PM for litigation. Council came back into session and out of litigation at 8:07 PM. Motion was made by T. Weikel seconded T. Moyer that we drop the lawsuit against Pentair Pump Company. Motion passed unanimously.
