

March 13, 2018

The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Present: A. Demchik, A. Dham, A. Metricarti, J. Moskal, T. Moyer, and T. Weikel
Also Present: Mayor J. Antoniewicz, Solicitor R. Brant, and Manager M. Leonard
Absent: M. Stehman

VISITORS: No visitors spoke at the meeting.

The minutes of the February 13 & 27, 2018 meeting were approved as amended upon a motion by T. Weikel seconded by J. Moskal. Motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:

Manager Leonard presented to Council Resolution #2018-03, a joint application with Limerick Township and Upper Providence Township to apply for a multimodal grant for sidewalk and drainage. Motion by T. Weikel seconded by T. Moyer. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard presented Resolution #2018-04, permission to apply for a \$15,000 grant to the Schuylkill Highlands Mini-Grant Program for phase 3 of the borough's river trail (Arch St. to Borough line). Motion by T. Weikel seconded by T. Moyer. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard presented Resolution #2018-05, permission to apply for a \$15,000 grant to the Schuylkill Highlands Mini-Grant Program for phase 4 of the borough's river trail (north side of Main Street trail). Motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard reported to Council that the roof was leaking in the Police Chief's office. Manager Leonard was getting some bids on the roof and asked if he could get permission to spend no more than \$3,000 on the repair of the roof. Motion by A. Metricarti seconded by T. Weikel to allow the manager to spend up to \$3,000 on the roof repair at Borough Hall. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard reported to Council that Unitech paid the Borough back \$35,000 for the crosswalk work that was done on the project at 3rd Avenue and Main Street.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$204,132.64 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

T. Weikel reported that the codification process is moving forward.

PARK & RECREATION COMMITTEE:

T. Moyer reminded Council that Saturday March 24th at 10 AM is the Easter Egg Hunt at Victory Park.

PLANNING COMMISSION:

A. Dham informed Council there will be a Planning Commission meeting on April 2, 2018 at 7 PM to review the plans for renovations of Phoenixville Bank.

A. Dham informed Council the parking study survey is almost completed to send out.

A. Dham informed Council that there will be NIMS training after the council meeting.

SOLICITOR:

Solicitor Brant reported that he, the borough staff, President Anil Dham, Tom Weikel, and Amy Demchik met with the owners of the brew pub to try to resolve some issues.

MAYOR:

Mayor Antoniewicz announced that there is a meeting for National Night Out to be held at 7 PM on March 20, 2018 at the UCC Church.

Mayor Antoniewicz announced to Council that there will be a meet and greet with the business community on Wednesday March 21, 2018 at the Pink Moose, 147 Main Street.

Mayor Antoniewicz announced to Council that she will be officiating at several weddings. The dates are Friday April 20th, Saturday June 9th, and New Year's Eve December 31st.

Mayor Antoniewicz stated there was a threat called into the Spring Ford School District 10-12 grade center. The Mayor wanted to send a special thank you to Chief Nerlinger for all the work he did regarding the threat.

ADJOURNMENT:

The meeting was adjourned at 7:32 PM upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.
