The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Motion by T. Weikel seconded by J. Moskal to approve the meeting minutes of April 10 & 24, 2018. Motion passed unanimously.

Ed Schoen addressed Council regarding a permit fee for a set of steps at 50 First Avenue. Council discussed and stated that they will work with Mr. Schoen on the fee.

Integrity Tattoo will hold its second annual carnival on June 2, 2018; proceeds will go to building a Vietnam Memorial along the river.

Manager Leonard presented to Council Resolution #2018-09 regarding the procedures to govern the procurement of professional services contracts regarding pension plans (Act 44).

Sacred Heart Church asked Council for two handicapped signs and to identify three other parking spaces in front of the parish office. Borough Council denied Sacred Heart Church request because they have a parking lot attached to the building.

The Second Avenue parking lot near Main Street should be done by Friday.

Myrtle Street parking lot should be started by the end of the month.
