The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:

Manager Leonard asked permission to advertise a mill and overlay project for Walnut Street from Lewis Road to Borough line. The project will not start until after July 15, 2019.

Manager Leonard asked permission from Council to bid the work needed at the sewer plant and the Green Street pump station.

Manager Leonard asked permission to install a temporary speed hump on Second Avenue. Motion by A. Metricarti seconded by J. Moskal. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard asked permission to install new stairs and a handicap ramp at the Police Department. The cost of the renovation is \$6,665.30. Motion by A. Metricarti seconded by T. Weikel. Motion passed unanimously.

Disbursements in the amount of \$239,218.89 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

Disbursements reported when the borough computer system was down from April 1 thru April 15 were presented and authorized to be paid in the amount of \$188,081.26. Motion by T. Weikel seconded by T. Moyer. Motion passed unanimously.
