The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

VISITORS: No visitors spoke at the meeting.

Motion by A. Metricarti seconded by M. Stehman to approve the meeting minutes of the May 14 and May 28, 2019 meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

Solicitor Brant updated on land swap #1 regarding the Veterans Memorial on North First Avenue. Mr. Brant also touched on land swap #2.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:

Manager Leonard asked permission to advertise the parking lot project at 4th & Main Street. Motion to advertise the 4th Avenue parking lot project including the wall as a separate project by J. Moskal seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard stated to Council that the Curb My Clutter agreement has been signed.

Manager Leonard reported that the Borough received a grant of \$16,000 from the Schuylkill River Highlands Mini Grant Program for Interpretive and Wayfinding Signs for the north side trail.

Disbursements in the amount of \$272,620.50 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by A. Metricarti seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.
