The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

VISITORS:

No visitors addressed Council.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT:

Solicitor R. Brant conducted a hearing for a liquor license transfer to 401-403 Main Street for a restaurant and bar owned by Colby Davis. Mr. Kenneth Butera was representing Mr. Davis. Mr. Butera asked Mr. Davis how many seats would be at the establishment; answer 89 seats. Will there be music at the establishment; yes on Friday and Saturday (no dancing). How many employees do you estimate you will employ; 30 employees. Who is the owner of the building; Mr. Davis stated Brad Sinrod is the owner of the building. Mr. Davis stated the establishment will be open Tuesday – Thursday 11 AM to 11PM Friday and Saturday 11AM-midnight. Mr. Brant asked the visitors if they had any questions. Larry Groves asked what kind of food will be served; Mr. Davis answered small plates, burgers. Before closing the hearing Solicitor Brant asked Council if they had any questions; Council person Alex Metricarti wanted to know if Mr. Davis had any experience in the restaurant business; he said between him and a friend who is helping him around 65 years' experience. With no other questions Mr. Brant closed the hearing. Mr. Brant stated that the hearing was advertised in the Pottstown Mercury. Motion by A. Metricarti seconded by M. Stehman that Borough Council approve the transfer of the liquor license. Motion was approved unanimously.

Solicitor Brant informed Council that they are still working on completing the Riverfront Ordinance.

Motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti that the minutes of the January 6, 14 & 28, 2020 meetings be approve. Motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:

Manager Leonard provided Borough Council with a copy of Resolution #2020-03 approving Tom Weikel the official voting delegate representing the Borough at the 109th General Assembly of Pennsylvania State Association of Boroughs. Motion by A. Metricarti seconded by T. Moyer to approve Resolution #2020-03. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard provided Borough Council with a copy of Resolution #2020-04 approving the intermunicipal transfer of a liquor license to 401-403 Main Street. Motion by A. Metricarti seconded by T. Moyer to approve Resolution #2020-04. Motion passed unanimously.

CDBG Grant mill and overlay on Church Street from 7th Avenue to Lewis Road is waiting for an environmental review by the County before we can start the project.

Zoning Hearings for Sacred Heart Church and Ace Hardware are looking for relief for a digital sign; I will pass out information to Council as I get it.

Motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti to put the bid out to replace the pipe across the road at Second Avenue from the park; following with the water company doing a mill and overlay of Second Avenue.

Disbursements in the amount of \$179,587.90 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman Motion passed unanimously.
