2 MR. KAVALER: Mr. Patrissi and
3 myself having indicated we were present for
4 this --

5 PRESIDENT SLIFKA: Your mic,
6 please, Mr. Kavalier.

7 MR. KAVALER: Mr. Patrissi and
8 myself having indicated being present when
9 the roll was taken, does that necessarily
10 require us to be here at the future date in
11 which this is taken up, or could the regular
12 members of the Council return to handle that
13 hearing?

14 PRESIDENT SLIFKA: I will
15 defer to Mr. O'Brien.

16 MR. O'BRIEN: Yes, they could
17 return to handle that matter.

18 MR. ALAIR: It's not a zoning
19 matter.

20 MR. O'BRIEN: It's not a
21 zoning matter anyways, but even if it was
22 they could return because they'll have heard
23 all the testimony.

24 MR. KAVALER: Okay. Thank
25 you.

1 MR. O'BRIEN: Active
2 participation would be required.

3 MR. KAVALER: Thank you.

4 PRESIDENT SLIFKA: Okay.

5 We're continued.


