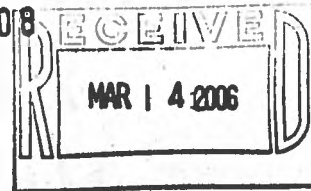

7 its administrative work.

8 MAYOR SLIFKA: Mr. Feldman. Is there

10 MR. JOSEPH VERRENGIA: Yes, what's the
11 dollar amount of the fee?

12 MR. FELDMAN: It's \$2.00.

13 MAYOR SLIFKA: Anyone else? Sign up
14 sheet, Mr. O'Brien?

15 MR. JOSEPH O'BRIEN: No one has signed up.

16 MAYOR SLIFKA: Okay, last call for the
17 handful out there. Anybody wishes, who did not sign up
18 who wishes to testify to the subject matter of this

21 the public hearing.


