

**MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING ON AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION
30-2 OF THE TOWN CODE OF ORDINANCES ESTABLISHING THE
PROCESS FOR SETTING THE WAGE AND SALARY RANGE FOR THE
POSITION OF PART-TIME ASSISTANT CORPORATION COUNSEL**

President Rob Bouvier called the hearing to order at 7:01 p.m.

President Bouvier: Thank you Mrs. Cronin. We have a copy of the ordinance for the record. Mr. Feldman.

Mr. Feldman: Mr. Mayor this is an ordinance that is presented to you really dealing with roles and responsibilities. What the ordinance does is that it gives the Council the authority, the responsibility to set an annual salary range for the part-time Assistant Corporation Counsel and then it goes on to designate the Corporation Counsel as the agent who would then set the specific salary so like you do in several other positions non-classified, non-bargaining unit positions you set a range, a minimum to maximum salary and then within the range the appointed agent then sets the salary and that is what this ordinance does for part-time Assistant Corporation Counsel.

President Bouvier: Thank you Mr. Feldman. Any questions from the Council? Is there a sign up sheet Mr. Alair?
