

**MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING ON AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE
WAITING PERIOD REQUIREMENT FOR DEMOLITION PERMITS**

May 9, 2000 Council Chambers 999, 381

President Rob Bouvier called the hearing to order at 7:30 p.m.

President Bouvier: Mr. Feldman.

Mr. Feldman: Mr. Mayor, as I'm sure you know this ordinance is predicated upon an active role played by the West Hartford Historic District Commission and as such we have not heard back from them. My suggestion is subject to their telling us specifically that they are okay with the ordinance the way it is drafted, would you keep the public hearing and maybe continue this maybe for another two weeks if schedule allows from tonight or four weeks?

President Bouvier: Certainly.

Mr. Feldman: So we can make sure that we get written comment back from them.

President Bouvier: I don't see a sign up sheet specific to this one. Is there anyone...

Councilor Shulansky: I think I passed it along.

President Bouvier: I have two of them here on the skating rink and the parking violations.

Mr. O'Connor: You could probably just ask if there is anyone here who wishes to speak?

President Bouvier: Yes. Is there anybody here who would like to come and speak to the period requirement for demolition permits please come forward at this time. If not we will keep the public hearing open and continue it.

Mrs. Cronin: To the next Council meeting?
