

MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING ON AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AGGREGATING \$13,951,000 TO FUND CERTAIN PROJECTS IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE FISCAL YEARS 1999-2000 AND 2000-2001 AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$13,951,000 BONDS OF THE TOWN TO MEET SAID APPROPRIATIONS AND PENDING THE ISSUANCE THEREOF THE MAKING OF TEMPORARY BORROWINGS FOR SUCH PURPOSE AND DECLARING THE TOWN'S OFFICIAL INTENT TO REIMBURSE EXPENDITURES FROM SUCH BORROWINGS.
