

MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING ON AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 161-1 OF THE WEST HARTFORD CODE OF ORDINANCES CONCERNING PAYMENTS OF MOTOR VEHICLE TAXES.

President Klebanoff: Mr. Feldman, I think all of us are pretty familiar with this but did you have a presentation?

Barry M. Feldman, Town Manager: Madam Mayor, the ordinance change is to change to only one time a year for payment on a tax on any motor vehicle in West Hartford as opposed to twice a year.

President Klebanoff: Thank you. Questions for Mr. Feldman? Mrs. McKernan.

Councilor McKernan: Mr. Feldman, this includes, I know the taxes on a boat they don't but on a trailer this also includes that kind of a vehicle or is it just automobiles?

Mr. Feldman: I believe, I'll let Mrs. Wilder comment if she knows.

Councilor McKernan: Is it anything on wheels?

Mr. Feldman: The ordinance, Madam Mayor, if I could, the ordinance is very specific. It says tax on motor vehicles.

Councilor McKernan: Okay.

President Klebanoff: Are there further questions? Is there anyone here who wishes to address the Council on this ordinance? If not, I will close the public hearing.
