

RESOLUTION 2015-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WESTTOWN TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF CHESTER, PENNSYLVANIA, SUPPORTING A SPECIAL OCCASION PERMIT FOR ST. MAXIMILIAN KOLBE CHURCH.

WHEREAS, Section 408.4 of Act 34 of July, 2007 (“the Act”), which amends the Commonwealth’s Liquor Code, authorizes the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to issue a Special Occasion Permit to an eligible entity located in a dry municipality if a copy of a resolution adopted by the municipality’s governing body confirming support for the issuance of the Special Occasion Permit is provided; and

WHEREAS, an application for a Special Occasion Permit filed under the Act must contain a copy of the resolution adopted by the municipality, supporting the Special Occasion Permit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, St. Maximilian Kolbe Church, a non-profit (501c3) organization located at 15 E. Pleasant Grove Rd, West Chester PA, has requested the support of the Board of Supervisors of Westtown Township for the proposed issuance of a Special Occasion Permit to its facilities within Westtown Township for a fundraising event being held on Saturday, April 25, with the understanding that said one-time only transfer must be approved by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Westtown Township finds that the approval of a Special Occasion Permit for St. Maximilian Kolbe Church will not adversely affect the welfare, health, peace and morals of the municipality or its residents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that by adoption of this resolution, Westtown Township approves of the proposed issuance of the Special Occasion Permit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Special Occasion Permit is subject to approval by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board.


