

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-12

WHEREAS, municipalities are responsible for the maintenance of any locally owned streets with those streets consisting of the roadbed and any other appendages there to including curbing and drainage, and;

WHEREAS, responsibility and maintenance of all roadway structures should be the responsibility of the owner of the road since the planning and construction of all such facilities will be undertaken by the owner, and;

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania owns a network of roads throughout the Commonwealth, and;

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation has begun the review of their policy on street maintenance, considering that the maintenance of any stormwater facilities could become the responsibility of the local governments;


