RESOLUTION NO 2007 – 9

A RESOLUTION OF THE SUPERVISORS OF WESTTOWN TOWNSHIP SUPPORTING THE ENACTMENT OF CURRENT LEGISLATION BEFORE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF PENNSYLVANIA KNOWN AS THE RETURNABLE BEVERAGE CONTAINER ACT AND ALSO KNOWN AS SENATE BILL NO. 1035 AS A MEANS TO PROMOTE THE RECYCLING OF BEVERAGE CONTAINERS AND PREVENT LITTER IN WESTTOWN TOWNSHIP AND THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 1035 (Session of 2007) known as the Returnable Beverage Container Act (the “Act”) is currently pending in the General Assembly of Pennsylvania before the Environmental Resources and Energy Committee;

WHEREAS, the Act would promote the return of beverage containers by placing a returnable deposit value on returnable beverage containers and allows for the redemption of empty returnable beverage containers;

WHEREAS, Westtown Township finds that the Act would be an effective means to promote the recycling of beverage containers and prevent litter in Westtown Township and in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEARBY RESOLVED by the Supervisors of Westtown Township, Chester County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. The Supervisors hereby supports the enactment of the Returnable Container Act as an effective means to promote the recycling of beverage containers and prevent litter in Westtown Township and in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
2. This Resolution is effective immediately.
