**RESOLUTION NO.
2005-19**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTTOWN, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING THE LOCAL DISCHARGE LIMITS OF CERTAIN POLLUTANTS TO THE TOWNSHIP'S SEWER SYSTEM BY INDUSTRIAL USERS AND ESTABLISHING VARIOUS APPLICATION, PERMIT AND INSPECTION FEES THAT THE TOWNSHIP MAY CHARGE TO INDUSTRIAL USERS OF THE TOWNSHIP'S SEWER SYSTEM WHO MUST PARTICIPATE IN THE PRETREATMENT OF INDUSTRIAL WASTES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 1 of Chapter 132 of the Westtown Township Code, Section 132-32, the Board of Supervisors shall establish and promulgate the local discharge standards for specific pollutants that may be discharged to the Township's sewer system by industrial users; and

WHEREAS, the local discharge standards for specific pollutants that are adopted herein have been approved by the Environmental Protection Agency and are mandated by 40 CFR part 403.5(c)(1); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 1 of Chapter 132 of the Westtown Township Code Section 132-32, the Board of Supervisors shall establish the various administrative fees, for industrial permits and inspections that the Township performs to inspect industrial users' facilities to ensure compliance with the pretreatment regulations in Chapter 132 of the Code;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The local discharge standards for specific pollutants that may be discharged to the Township's sewer system by industrial users are as follows:

Bis (2-Ethyl Hexyl) Phthalate	0.186
Copper	0.42
Cyanide	0.042
Lead	0.16
Mercury	0.0005
Oil & Grease	100
pH	609 su
Phosphorus	30.6
Tetrachloroethene	0.073
Zinc	0.35

2. The local discharge standards established herein shall be effective as of the date of enactment of this Resolution.


3. The fees that the Township shall charge to industrial users who are required to obtain industrial use permits and participate in the Township's Pretreatment Program for industrial wastes are as follows:

4. The fees established therein shall be effective as of the date of enactment of this Resolution.


