

RESOLUTION 2015-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WESTTOWN TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF CHESTER, PENNSYLVANIA, FOR PLAN REVISION FOR NEW LAND DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act", as Amended, and the rules and Regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, require the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters of the Commonwealth and/or environmental health hazards from sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to determine whether a proposed method of sewage disposal for a new land development conforms to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management, and

WHEREAS, Charles L. & Judith B. Stinedurf ^{have} proposed the development of a parcel of land identified as "905 Oakbourne Road, Westtown Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, Tax Parcel No. 67-2-1.4", and described in the attached Sewage Facilities Planning Module, and proposes that such subdivision be served by a small flow treatment facility

WHEREAS, Westtown Township finds that the subdivision described in the attached Sewage Facilities Planning Module conforms to applicable sewage related zoning and other sewage related municipal ordinances and plans, and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Westtown Township hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Sewage Facilities Plan" of the municipality the above referenced Sewage Facilities Planning Module which is attached hereto.
