Be it RESOLVED, that Westtown Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania hereby requests a Park Rehabilitation and Development (PRD) 50/50 matching grant from the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Recreation (PA DCNR) to be used for the Tyson Park Phase 2 of the Constructed Bio-Swale Project for ADA Accessibility and further bio-swale enhancements. The total amount of the project is to be \$132,125.00


Be it RESOLVED, that if Westtown Township is awarded the above grant, it is committed to providing the necessary 50/50 matching funds, or \$66,062.00 in cash from the General Fund.
