**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WESTTOWN TOWNSHIP,
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DETERMINING MILEAGE
REIMBURSEMENT FOR TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS, EMPLOYEES, AND OTHER
BOARD OR COMMISSION MEMBERS**

WHEREAS, under Section 606 of the Second Class Township Code, the Board of Supervisors may establish a mileage allowance under the Act of July 20, 1979, referred to as the Uniform Mileage Fee Law, to be paid to Township Supervisors, employees, and other Board or Commission members for the use of personal vehicles when required and actually used for authorized Township business.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Westtown Township that, effective January 1, 2018:

1. Authorized reimbursable mileage for Township Supervisors and Board or Commission members shall include Police Commission Meetings, PSATS Meetings, Regional Meetings and any other meeting and/or any other official Township business held outside of the Township Building and/or the Township borders.
2. Non-reimbursable mileage shall include Township monthly meetings and workshops, and/or other meetings held within the Township Building and/or the Township's borders.
3. Authorized reimbursable mileage for employees shall include all official Township business, excluding the regular daily commute to and from the Township.
4. The Township reimbursable mileage rate shall be the prevailing standard business mileage rate adopted by the Internal Revenue Service pursuant to Westtown Township Resolution 2013-4.
